



ABMA AC 2022 Covid Safety Protocols and Procedures

We will be implementing these additional safety protocols on-site at the meeting:

- We will have stickers for your badge of varying colors for you to choose indicating:
 - Green - everything is good, shake hands, hug, not concerned about personal space
 - Yellow – no handshakes or hugs but not concerned about social distancing, comfortable about being around people in a room.
 - Red – NO contact. Please respect my personal space
- It is also important to note that we may not be social distanced in our meeting space (network rooms, exhibit hall, general sessions, etc.)
- Hand sanitizer and wipes will be out and about our meeting space. Extra masks will be available upon requests. The rooms will be cleaned often.

While safety protocols will be in place to mitigate the spread of COVID-19, we cannot ensure a virus-free environment.
